4	had worked and retired as the first Secretary of the Department of Transportation at the FSM
5	National Government; After returning to the State of Kosrae, he had served as the Director of
6	Public Works for several years, then after running for the Office of Governor, the late Robert
7	James Weilbacher was elected as the Sixth Governor and Chief Executive for the State of
8	Kosrae, from 2007 – 2011.

10	government but in the lives of his family, his friends, and even of those he did not know; He was
11	highly regarded as always approachable, cheerful, thoughtful, honest, modest, patient, calm, and
