Elden Buck was a pastor of the Korean Christian Church/ 8 United Church of Christ in Honolulu from 1981 to 1989 and of the First United Protestant 9 Church/ UCC of Hilo, Hawaii from 1990 to 1997; and 10 WHEREAS, the late Rev. Elden Buck, following his retirement in 1998, spent many 11 months on Kosrae researching and writing, while his late wife Alice continued her work as 12 13 coordinator of a new translation of the Kosraean Bible; and WHEREAS, the late Rev. Elden Buck is survived by three adult children and has six 14 grandchildren, two step-grandchildren, and a step-great-granddaughter; and 15 WHEREAS, the late Rev. Elden Buck is famously known by the people of Kosrae as a 16 special individual who significantly helped put the people, as well as the State of Kosrae, on the 17
