To amend the Kosrae State Code by repealing Section 4.304 (2) of Title 4, Section 5.508 (2) of Title 5, and Section 6.1206 (2) of Title 6 of the Kosrae State code; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1           Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by  
2   repealing Section 4.304 (2) of Title 4, Section 5.508 (2) of Title 5, and Section 6.1206 (2)  
3   of Title 6 of the Kosrae State Code.

4           Section 2. Amendment. Title 4, Chapter 3, Section 4.304 (2) of the Kosrae State  
5   Code is hereby repealed:

6           Section 4.304. Representation funds.

7   Except as herein specified, in addition to compensation provided by this chapter, a Senator  
8   is entitled to receive reimbursement for actual expenses incurred in the performance of the

9   duties of the office to the extent funds are appropriated for that specific purpose, as determined  
10   by each branch head. (Amendment by SKilling)
