

A RESOLUTION

Respectfully urging the Governor of the State to designate the Office of KIRMA to effect the minimal increase proposed for the recycling project program.

1           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 19.601 of the Kosrae State Code, this Chapter  
2 establishes a recycling program for the State of Kosrae whereby the State of Kosrae shall from  
3 time to time appoint a recycling agent to collect such waste materials as are designated by  
4 regulation and to the extent possible dispose of such material by sale and shipment from Kosrae;  
5 and

6           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 19.602, subsection (3) of the Kosrae State Code, stated  
7 that a recycling agent may contract with a Recycling Operator to operate the recycling program;  
8 and

9           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 19.603 of the Kosrae State Code, stated that the  
10 Administrator shall promulgate rules and regulations, guidelines, programs, and operating  
11 principles as may be deemed proper and necessary in the light of government policies and  
12 objectives of this Chapter.

13           (1) The rules and regulations, guidelines, programs, and operating principles shall be in  
14 writing and shall be designated as the Recycling Program Regulations.

15           (2) Before taking effect, the Recycling Program Regulations must be approved by resolution  
16 by the Legislature.

17           (3) Amendments to the Recycling Program Regulations must be approved by resolution by  
18 the Legislature; and

1           **WHEREAS**, eventually the recycling project encounters financial constraints upon its  
2 operations thence pledged for the assistance of the Kosrae State Government to increase the  
3 current charge rate of 6¢ to 7¢; and

4           **WHEREAS**, following the public hearing held by Committee on ETC&I with the Office  
5 of KIRMA, the Recycling Operator, and the Office of Division of Finance regarding the  
6 increasing effort, the Members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature hereby supports the  
7 increasing effort; **now therefore**

8           **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature hereby  
9 submits this subject resolution to respectfully urge the Governor to designate the Office of  
10 KIRMA to effect the slight increase proposed for the recycling program; endorse their support of  
11 the minimal increase for the recycling project program and further moved for adoption of this  
12 subject resolution, and


13           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to
