#### A RESOLUTION

Expressing the Kosrae State Legislature's sincerest condolences, acknowledgements, and respects in relation to the passing of the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk and its genuine appreciation for his many years of dedicated services to the people of the State of Kosrae and the Federated States of Micronesia.

WHEREAS, the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk was born on the 9<sup>th</sup> of May, 1958 and called to his eternal rest on the 12th of December, 2022; and 2 WHEREAS, the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk had passionately dedicated his 3 life serving his family, community, the State of Kosrae, and the FSM Nation; and 4 WHEREAS, the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk began his formal education at the 5 Utwe Elementary School in 1964 and graduated in 1972; He later enrolled at the Yekula High 6 School, where he was once a Student Officer and graduated in 1976; He then enrolled and 7 graduated at the Lassen Community College in 1978, where he majored in Liberal Arts; He then 8 enrolled at the California State University, Chico, where he majored in International Relations 9 and minored in Public Administrations; and 10 WHEREAS, the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk began his professional career as a 11 Classroom Teacher at the Utwe Elementary School from October, 1984 to January, 1985; Then 12 from March, 1987 to May, 1988, he became an Education Specialist I for the Department of 13 Education and later promoted to Education Specialist II for the same department; He was then 14 again promoted to Personnel Specialist II for the Division of Personnel & Employment Services, 15 from June, 1990 to May, 1992; In May of 1992, he was recruited by the FSM Office of the 16 President as a Special Assistant to the Vice President, where he diligently performed his duties 17

until August of 1999; In September of 1999, the late former Senator Waguk was again hired by 1 the FSM Congress as an Assistant Public Information Officer, where he performed his duties 2 until June of 2007; In June of 2007, he was again hired by the FSM Office of the President as 3 the Special Assistant for Legislative Matters until January of 2010; Then, in February of 2010, 4 he returned back to his home island and immediately was hired by the Office of the Governor, 5 Kosrae State Government, as the Special Assistant to the Governor, where he worked for a year; 6 And then in January of 2011, after successfully winning one of the two seats for the Utwe 7 delegation to the Kosrae State Legislature, the late former Senator Waguk was inaugurated as 8 one of the fourteen members of the 10<sup>th</sup> Kosrae State Legislature, representing the Utwe electoral 9 district; Later again, after his first four years in office, the late former Senator Waguk ran again 10 in 2015 and got re-elected to the 11th Kosrae State Legislature, representing his people and 11 community of Utwe; and 12 WHEREAS, the members of the Kosrae State Legislature find it immensely pertinent to 13 pay due respect, recognition, and tribute to the legacy of the late former Senator Josaiah F. 14 Waguk, appropriately so, as demonstrated by his professional imprints at the Legislature as 15 revealed herein: As a member of the 10<sup>th</sup> Kosrae State Legislature, the late former Senator 16 Waguk was the Chairman for the Committee on Resources & Development (R&D), a member of 17 the Judiciary & Governmental Operations (J&GO) Committee, and a member of the Health & 18 Social Affairs (H&SA) Committee; In his second term as a member of the 11th Kosrae State 19 Legislature, the late former Senator Waguk was the Vice Chairman for the Committee on 20

1	Environment, Transportation, Communication, & Infrastructure (ETC&I), a member of the
2	Judiciary & Governmental Operations (J&GO) Committee, and a member of the Education and
3	Cultural Affairs (E&CA) Committee; and
4	WHEREAS, the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk was also a well-known public
5	servant and greatly respected by his peers for his avid patriotism and leadership skills in his civic
6	duties and responsibilities, where he was once the Vice President of the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Utwe Charter
7	Commission, once a Vice President of the Utwe Adult Endeavor, and once a PTA Board Officer
8	for the Utwe Elementary School; Also known for his devoted faith and involvement in church,
9	the late former Senator became an ordained Lay Minister, where he eventually became one of the
10	ordained Deacons for the Utwe Congregational Church, until his passing; and
11	WHEREAS, the members of the Kosrae State Legislature mourn the passing of a close
12	friend, colleague, and fellow legislator; and
13	WHEREAS, the late former Senator Josaiah F. Waguk is survived by his wife Virginia J.
14	Waguk, two sons: Reed J. Floyd (married to Heidi R. Floyd) and Josaiah J. Waguk, Jr., three
15	daughters: Millicher (married to Raleigh S. Sigrah), Bessie (married to Shiro Nena), and Lerina
16	(married to Timothy Kephas), and eight grandkids: Elmerlyn R. Sankey, Saiyolyn R. Sankey,
17	Patrick R. Sankey, Carmelia R. Sankey, Naiyana R. Floyd, Yokiana R. Floyd, Alokoa Jb. Floyd,
