Expressing, on behalf of the people of Kosrae, the sincerest condolences and respects in relation to the passing of the late Ms. Tulpe K. William and its utmost appreciation for her many years of dedicated service to the people of the State of Kosrae.

1           **WHEREAS**, the late Ms. Tulpe K. William was born on the 12<sup>th</sup> of March, 1958, and  
2 called to her eternal rest on the 28<sup>th</sup> of December, 2021; and

3           **WHEREAS**, the late Ms. Tulpe K. William was the oldest sibling among two (2)  
4 brothers and six (6) sisters of Kiaru William and Kathlyn Kiaru William; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the late Ms. Tulpe K. William had dedicated much of her time serving the  
6 Kosrae State Government for a total of forty-five (45) years as a Finance Staff, which she began  
7 her career as a Clerk Typist I in September 20<sup>th</sup>, 1976; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the late Ms. Tulpe K. William during her career, was also known by her  
9 colleagues as a well-respected employee and reliable where she started off as an Account Clerk I  
10 in February of 1980, an Account Technician in January of 1984, an Accountant I in October of  
11 1991, then an Accountant II on October of 1997 and eventually Accountant III on November of  
12 1997 for the Kosrae Finance Office of the Kosrae State Government until her passing; and

13           **WHEREAS**, the late Ms. Tulpe K. William, aside from being a devoted employee, she  
14 was also a well – recognized member in her community as a supportive member and leader to  
15 her community group, Lelu K.K. Warriors, her Christian endeavor group, Sangkumi, which she  
16 served as Women President, Vice President, and Secretary, and she was also known to be a well  
17 – respected family member; and

13 acknowledgements, and respects in relation to the passing of the late Ms. Tulpe K. William; and


14           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to
