A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the Kosrae State Code by amending Section 5.202(1) of Title 5, by inserting a new subsection (j), to allow for requested payroll allotments from third parties as an obligatory service of the Department of Administration and Finance; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1           Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by  
2 amending Section 5.202(1) of Title 5, by inserting a new subsection (j) to allow for  
3 requested payroll allotments from third parties as an obligatory service of the Department  
4 of Administration and Finance; and for other purposes.

5           Section 2. Amendment. Title 5, Section 5.202(1)(j) of the Kosrae State Code is  
6 hereby inserted to read as follows:

7           “Section 5.202. Powers and duties of principal departments.

8 In addition to other powers and duties provided by law a director of a principal department  
9 is responsible to the Governor for the exercise of the departmental powers and duties  
10 indicated below by subsection. The Governor may delegate additional Executive powers  
11 and duties to a director as the Governor deems necessary.

12           (1)    The Department of Administration and Finance

13                   (a) provides budgetary and grant application advice to the  
14                               Executive and to other components of Government when  
15                               directed by the Governor.

16                   (b) prepares the annual budget and supplementary requests for  
17                               appropriations;


- 1 (c) maintains State statistics, and is the central repository of  
2 Government records of birth, deaths, marriages and other  
3 Government records required in the preparation of statistics;  
4 (d) collects revenues and reimbursements;  
5 (e) operates the Government's financial management system;  
6 (f) administers the Public Service System in accordance with Title  
7 18 of the Kosrae State Code;  
8 (g) monitors employment conditions in the private sector;  
9 (h) provides public notice of Executive policies.;  
10 (i) provides JEMCO, OIA and OCM reports to the appropriate  
11 State departments and offices.  
12 (j) provides/ allows for requested payroll allotments from third  
13 parties. The deduction and payment of amounts to a third party  
14 upon an employee shall be an obligatory service of the  
15 department.

17 Section 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor  
18 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
