A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend State Law No. 12-92, as amended by State Law Nos. 12-100, 12-129 and 12-130 at Sections 2(2)(e), 14(e), 11, and 12 (8) to extend lapse date from September 30, 2021 to later specified date for each programs/projects; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to extend the lapsed date for Section 2,
2 subsection 2(e), Section 14(e), Section 11, and 12 (8) extending the lapse date to a later date as
3 specified for each . The intend of the extensions are; for the Department of Education, to allow
4 applicable time for procurement of School bus; for the Department of Health Services to secure
5 procurement of equipments an ambulance and equipments; and for the Department of Resources
6 and Economic Affair to have sufficient time to implement the Rabbitfish Farming project.

7 Section 2. Amendment. State Law No. 12-92 as amended by State Law Nos. 12-100, 12-
8 129 and 12-130, is further amended at Section 2, subsections 2(e), to read as follows:

9 “...Section 1. Appropriations. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$6,904,866, or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum
11 of \$1,062,205 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue
12 Fund; the sum of \$971,401 ,or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
13 United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$455,113 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
14 appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the

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1 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, provided that the lapse date for subsection 2(e) ending on
2 September 30, 2022 and subsection 14(e) ending on March 31, 2022 .

3 Section 2. Apportionment. Operation of the Executive. The sums appropriated by
4 Section 1 of this act are apportioned as follows: ...

2 Section 11. Appropriation. The sum of \$1,412,325, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
3 is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the purpose
4 of funding certain Governmental programs, grants, and contributions for the fiscal year ending
5 September 30, 2021, provided that subsection 8 below ending on September 30, 2022.

6 Section 12. Apportionment. The sums appropriated by Section 11 of this act is apportioned
7 as follows:
