## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the Kosrae State Code by repealing Section 2.901(2)(d) in its entirety and to be renumbered accordingly; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1	Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by
2	repealing Section 2.901(2)(d) in its entirety and renumbered accordingly; and for other purposes.
3	Section 2. Amendment. Section 2.901(2)(d), Chapter 9, Title 2 of the Kosrae State Code is
4	hereby repealed in its entirety:
5	"(2) A State lawyer must:
6	(a) Be or become admitted to practice before the Kosrae State Court within 3
7	months of hiring;
8	(b) Be or become admitted to practice before the Supreme Court of the
9	Federated States of Micronesia within three years of hiring; and
10	(c) For purposes of this statute "hiring" means the date upon which a
11	contract employee begins working for compensation.
12	(d) Any person employed as a State Lawyer who fails to meet the
13	requirements of Subsection (2) within the time limits of that subsection
14	shall be immediately dismissed from the position by the State Lawyer's
15	Branch Head and may not be reemployed as a State lawyer until he meets
16	all requirements.
