A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend State Law No. 13-37, as amended by State Law Nos. 13-42 and 13-48, to supplement the operational budget for fiscal year 2024 modifying the allocations for the Amended Compact Sector Fund per CR3, correcting office budget amounts and inclusion of a 45% salary increase, pursuant to State Law Nos. 13-40 and 13-46; and for other purposes.

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to supplement the fiscal year 2024 operational budget by modifying the allocations for the Amended Compact Sector Fund per CR3, correcting office budget amounts and inclusion of 45% salary increase to all government employees, pursuant to State Law Nos. 13-40 and 13-46.

Section 2. Amendments. State Law No. 13-37 is hereby further amended to read as follows:
