Urging the Governor to advise the Department of Administration & Finance to immediately rescind its January 13th Memorandum, indefinitely.

1 **WHEREAS**, during the middle part of 2020, the Department of Administration &
2 Finance (DAF) had communicated by memorandum to the business community, particularly to
3 banking and lending institutions utilizing the payroll allotment service, informing them of DAF's
4 intention to discontinue this service by January, 2021; and

5 **WHEREAS**, due to some businesses' requests for additional time to prepare for this
6 transition, the State Department of Administration & Finance, once again by memorandum,
7 rescinded the first date and extended the deadline to June, 2021; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the issue was then brought forth to the attention of the 12th Kosrae State
9 Legislature as a miscellaneous concern, who then reacted by holding public hearings to the
10 Department of Administration & Finance and also representatives of the two major banking
11 institutions in Kosrae; and

12 **WHEREAS**, after carefully considering the testimonies provided during the public
13 hearings, the members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature, in consensus, have decided to
14 intervene by way of this legislative resolution; **NOW & THEREFORE**

15 **BE IT RESOLVED**, by the members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature, during its
16 Fifth Regular Session, February, 2021, hereby urge the Governor to advise the Department of
17 Administration & Finance to immediately rescind its January 13th Memorandum, indefinitely;

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to
2 The Honorable Carson K. Sigrah, Governor of the State of Kosrae; and Director Rensley A.
3 Sigrah, Department of Administration & Finance.






