A RESOLUTION

Requesting the FSM Office of the President to assist the State of Kosrae with its problem with Continental Airlines' current flight schedule to and from Kosrae.

Whereas, since June 2005 the Continental Airlines had implemented a new flight 1 2 schedule to and from Kosrae; Whereas, this new schedule flights reduced the number of flights originating from 3 4 Guam from three to once a week; Whereas, this new flight schedule adversely impacted the orderly lives of the 5 6 residents of the State, its businesses as well as much needed government services; 7 Whereas, the new flight schedule had particularly and significantly compounded 8 problems the State Department of Health Services has in the areas of medical supplies 9 procurement and medical referral; Whereas, reduced number of eastbound flights from Kosrae poses unnecessary 10 11 hardships in the timely transportation of patients under the medical referral program that 12 need to be treated abroad; 13 Whereas, Continental Airlines current policy does not allow special treatment for 14 emergency situation; 15 Whereas, medical supplies regularly ordered and sent from New Zealand, Guam 16 and Pohnpei are continuously delayed as a result of this new flight schedule; now and 17 therefore 18 Be it resolved, that the Kosrae State Legislature, on behalf of the people of Kosrae, respectfully requests the FSM National Government, Office of the President, to 19 take upon itself to address this urgent matter with Continental Airlines; and 20 21 Be it further resolved, that certified copies of this resolution shall be transmitted 22 to His Excellency, the Honorable Joseph J.
