A RESOLUTION

Requesting the 21st Congress to revisit the Social Security Act, to consider extending the age requirement to receive 50% Social Security benefits beyond the age of 64 years for employees.

1 **WHEREAS**, Title 53, Section 804 of the FSM Code sets out the age of Social
2 Security benefits; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Public Law 16-10, sets a delay of implementation of Social Security
4 retirement benefits received by individuals between the ages 60 and 64, for one year for
5 full benefits to be received and further sets that individuals between ages 60 and 64
6 receive 50% of benefits; and

7 **WHEREAS**, many individuals have the ability to work in the workforce beyond
8 the age of 64; and

9 **WHEREAS**, these individuals who work beyond the age of 64 should be entitled
10 to **50% benefits** until he/she is discontinues from the workforce; **NOW THEREFORE** it
11 is requested that the 21st Congress revisit Title 53 of the current Social Security Laws .

12 ~~**BE IT RESOLVED**~~, that this Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature, on its Fifth
13 Regular Session, February 2021, requests the 21st Congress to revisit the Social Security
14 Act, to consider extending the age requirement to receive 50% Social Security benefits
15 beyond the age of 64 years for employees; and


