A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Title 5 of the Kosrae State Code, by amending Section 5.208 thereof, to require a minimum of twenty-five percent (25%) of each infrastructure project fund, to be expended locally on materials or supplies needed for the construction of such projects; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to amend Section 5.208 of Title 5 of
2 the Kosrae State Code, by inserting a new subsection (3), to require a minimum of twenty-
3 five (25%) of each infrastructure project fund to be expended in the State of Kosrae or
4 locally, on materials or supplies needed for the construction of such projects.

5 Section 2. Amendment. Title 5, Chapter 2, Section 5.208(3) of the Kosrae State
6 Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 “Section 5.208. Infrastructure Planning and Implementation Committee.

8 The Infrastructure Planning and Implementation Committee (IPIC) shall be chaired by the
9 Lieutenant Governor and shall consist of the Department Heads, two members of the
10 Kosrae State Legislature and such other persons as the Governor shall appoint.

11 (1) At least two weeks before transmitting any infrastructure priority
12 recommendations to the FSM National Government, IPIC shall transmit a
13 copy of the proposed recommendations to the Legislature for review and
14 comment. In case the Legislature is unable to meet for session, the
15 Legislature’s Standing Committee on Judiciary and Government

1 Operations shall act on behalf of the Legislature to provide comment or
2 endorsement to the IPIC proposed recommendations.

3 (2) A Project Management Office (PMO) is established to monitor and manage
4 the implementation of Compact Sector infrastructure projects, and inform
5 and support development and implementation of requisite policies.

6 (3) Unless expressly provided otherwise by the project financial sponsors,
7 lenders, grantors or the likes, a required minimum of twenty-five percent
8 (25%) of each infrastructure project fund shall be expended in the State of
9 Kosrae or locally on materials or supplies needed for the construction of
10 such projects.”


11 Section 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor
12 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
