A RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, the first ever Micronesia (FSM) Cultural Expo was hosted by the State of
- 2 Pohnpei during the week of July 18 to July 22, 2022. The Delegation from Kosrae consisted of
- 3 50 individuals that were patriotically willing to represent the State of Kosrae for the Micronesia
- 4 (FSM) Cultural Expo; and
- 5 **WHEREAS,** the State of Kosrae created a delegation that was headed by the Lt.
- 6 Governor, T.H Arthy G. Nena and joint by Speaker of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature, T.H.
- 7 Tulensa W. Palik and five members of Kosrae State Legislature, DOE Director Tulensru E.
- 8 Waguk, Ph.D., Utwe Youth Group, KVB employees and Board, R J Store, WaWa's Chips,
- 9 carvers, weavers and fahfah pounders; and
- 10 WHEREAS, on July 14, the Kosrae Delegation departed at Okat Harbor on the
- 11 Micronesia Navigator Vessel and arrived in Pohnpei on July 16, 2022. Upon their arrival on
- Pohnpei, the Kosrae Expo Delegation was warmly welcomed by the Pohnpei Expo staff. On the
- 13 18th of July, the opening of Expo kicked off, where each State delegation paraded down from the
- Pohnpei State Governor's Office to the Gymnasium. Soon right after, the Pohnpei Delegation did
- 15 their "A Day in Pohnpei" activities, showcasing their cultural heritage with traditional dances
- and performances, including their infamous sakau ritual; Likewise, the week-long event was

completed successfully with "A Day in Yap" on the 19th, "A Day in Kosrae" on the 20th and "A 1 2 Day in Chuuk" on 21st of July, 2022; and WHEREAS, during the "A Day in Kosrae", the Kosrae Delegation started their day with 3 an opening remark from the Lt. Governor followed by the Utwe Youth Group energetic 4 5 performance, followed by the Nweklahp presentation by a group of ladies, with Senator Sasaki 6 George and the wife singing three numbers. Furthermore, the demonstrations also included the 7 making the traditional Kosraean um, Kosraean soup, building of Kosraean house and demo of 8 other Kosraean Cuisine. A day in Kosrae went well with the generous support and assistance 9 from the Kosrae Kolonia Congregation Church, friends and family in Pohnpei; and WHEREAS, on July 30th, 2022, the Kosrae Delegation along with Kosraeans who were 10 11 planning to board went to Pohnpei dock and waited for the Micronesia Navigator to be boarded. 12 The passengers unfortunately spent a night on the Micronesia Navigator Vessel, which stirred up 13 a lot of concerned citizens and groups, such as the Muslim Community, National R&D staff, voluntary individuals, and Kosraean resident in Pohnpei who graciously decided to contribute 14 water, food and other necessities to those stranded on the ship. A day later, the ship departed 15 from the Pohnpei dock on July 31st and arrived on August 2nd 2022 at the Okat dock. At last, 16 17 upon arrival at the Okat, refreshments and drinks were prepared by the Utwe Youth Group and
