To further amend Title 10, Section 10.205 of the Kosrae State Code, as amended by S.L. No. 11-10, S.L. No. 11-71, S.L. No. 11-104, S.L. No. 11-117, S.L. No. 11-146, and S.L. No. 11-157, to correct the alphabetization of the subsections; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to correct the alphabetization of the

2 subsections of Section 10.205.

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- Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. Title 10, Section 10.205 of the Kosrae State Code is

 pursuant to this section transmits the monies within seven days of receipt to the
