A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the Kosrae State Code by establishing a new provision under Chapter 13 of Title 17, to establish a new police substation in Walung for Public Safety and further renumbering the current Chapter 13 and subsequent chapters to reflect such changes; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to insert new provisions under
2 section Chapter 13 of Title 17, to establish a substation for Public Safety at Municipalities
3 Walung; and for other purposes.

4 Section 2. Amendment. Title 17, Chapter 13, Section 17.1301 of the Kosrae State
5 Code is hereby amended to read as follows :

6 "Section 17.1222. Other offense. A person brought back to the State by, or after
7 waiver of, extradition proceeding, is subject to trial in the State for an offense other than
8 the offense which occasioned the proceedings. Cross-reference:

10 Chapter 13. Section 17.1301 Public Safety substations: The following
11 substations are hereby established.



3 Attorney General may confiscate and preserve for a court's disposition, or destroy if he
4 finds an immediate danger to the public welfare, matter which a person is using or
5 possessing in violation of law, or the existence of which violates law.

6 Chapter 14 15. Inter-government Enforcement Section 17.44 1501. National
7 government. The Government enforces national law only pursuant to a written agreement
8 |executed by the Governor with the national government| on behalf of the Government, and
9 only if the agreement provides that the Government receives fair compensation for its
10 services to the national government. Section 17.44~~15~~02. Municipal governments. The
11 Government enforces municipal penal law pursuant to an agreement with a municipal
12 government for the reciprocal enforcement of State and municipal penal law.

13 Section 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor
14 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
