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A RESOLUTION

To further extend the Governor's Declaration of a State of Emergency made on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 as amended and extended.

1           **WHEREAS**, the Governor made a Declaration of a State of Emergency on March 17<sup>th</sup>,  
2 2020; and

3           **WHEREAS**, members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature pursuant to Section 13  
4 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of Kosrae considered the Declaration of State of  
5 Emergency as amended and extended; and

6           **WHEREAS**, members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature after noticing that the  
7 Declaration of State of Emergency as amended and extended is due to expire on 30<sup>th</sup> September,  
8 2021 and perceiving that COVID-19 still remains a threat in regards to which precautionary  
9 measures need to be further established, maintained and supplemented and thereby perceiving  
10 that it is essential that the Declaration of State of Emergency as amended and extended thereafter  
11 be extended by 123 days to enable the Kosrae State to continue to be in a state of preparedness to  
12 adequately respond to the threat posed by COVID-19; **NOW AND THEREFORE**

13           **BE IT RESOLVED**, by members of the Twelfth Kosrae State Legislature that pursuant  
14 to Article V, Section 13 of the Kosrae State Constitution that the Declaration of State of  
15 Emergency as amended and extended be further extended for a period of one-hundred twenty-  
16 three (123) days from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2021 and expires on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2022; and

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1        **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to  
2 The Honorable Carson K. Sigrah, Governor of the State of Kosrae.
