A RESOLUTION

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Jesse A. Robert, son of the late Mr. Andy L. Robert, a former Police  
2 Officer of the Kosrae State Police Force, and Mrs. Irene A. Robert of Lelu; and

3           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Jesse A. Robert graduated as an Honor Student at the Kosrae High  
4 School, later pursued his educational career at the University of Hawaii, Hilo from 2008 to 2016,  
5 where he achieved his Bachelor of Arts in Math and Master of Arts in Teacher; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Jesse A. Robert later applied for a job and was hired as a Classroom  
7 Teacher for the Kealakehe Intermediate School, where he worked there from 2015 to 2019 and  
8 later taught at the Keaau Middle School from 2019 to 2022; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Jesse A. Robert later enlisted to the U.S. Armed Forces and began  
10 serving in 2017 until present times; while serving, he was stationed in Hilo, Hawaii, where he  
11 served under the 871<sup>st</sup> Airborne Engineering Company, a Reserve Unit, and


12           **WHEREAS**, since enlistment, Mr. Jesse A. Robert sacrificed his time and effort serving

15 as a Police Officer of the Hawaii Police Department in Hilo, Hawaii; and




