A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Title 10 of the Kosrae State Code by adding a new Subsection 10.205(n) to establish the Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to amend Title 10 of the Kosrae
2 State Code by adding a new Subsection 10.205 (n) to establish the Division of Public
3 Safety Revolving Fund and provided that any variations in generated fees shall be
4 deposited into this revolving fund and the remaining fee shall be deposited into the Kosrae
5 State Treasury.

6 Section 2. Amendment. Title 10 Section 10.205 of the Kosrae State Code is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 “Section 10.205(n). Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund.

9 (1) There is created and established the Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund
10 separate from the General Fund of the State of Kosrae and all other funds.

11 (2) The purpose of the Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund is to establish an
12 ongoing revolving fund to allow collection of seventy percent of all traffic citations fines;
13 vehicle registration fees; State issued driver’s license permits; State issued Identification
14 Cards; State Police Clearance fees and to further allow for Legislative appropriations to be
15 deposited into the fund and shall be used State Police administrative and operational
16 purposes.

1 (3) All future appropriations along with seventy percent of fines and fees collected
2 shall be deposited into the fund; provided that at no time shall the total amount of monies
3 in the Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund exceed \$50,000.00; and provided further,
4 that any monies collected and deposited which would cause the total amount of monies in
5 the revolving fund to exceed \$50,000.00 shall be deposited into the State
6 General/Treasury Fund. Any unexpended monies in the Division of Public Safety
7 Revolving Fund shall not revert the State Treasury Fund nor lapse at the end of the fiscal
8 year.

9 (4) The Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund shall be administered by the
10 State Chief of Police. The Chief shall, not later than 30 days after the close of each
11 governmental fiscal year, submit to the Attorney General a complete report of the
12 activities and condition of the Division of Public Safety Revolving Fund for the fiscal year
13 just closed. The Attorney General shall, within 30 days of receipt of the report from the
14 Chief of Police, forward the report to the Governor and the Speaker and members of the
15 Kosrae State Legislature.

16 (5) The State Public Auditor shall audit the Division of Public Safety Revolving
17 Fund at such time as the Public Auditor deems appropriate.”

18 Section 3.Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor
19 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
