A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Chapter 5 of Title 13 of the Kosrae State Code, by inserting a new Section 13.516 (17) thereof, to prohibit the selling of alcoholic drinks on Christmas Eve and New Year’s Eve, starting from 0001 hours to 2400 hours, for each particular date, except where the holder of a restaurant license is permitted to sell alcoholic drinks to a seated diner; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to amend Chapter 5 of Title 13 of
2 the Kosrae State Code, by inserting a new Section 13.516 (17), to prohibit the selling of
3 alcoholic drinks on Christmas Eve and New Year’s Eve, starting from 0001 hours to 2400
4 hours, for each particular date, except where the holder of a restaurant license is permitted
5 to sell alcoholic drinks to a seated diner; and for other purposes.

6 Section 2. Amendment. Chapter 5 of Title 13 of the Kosrase State Code is hereby
7 amended to include a new Section 13.516 (17) to read as follows:

8 “Section 13.516. Unauthorized selling of alcoholic drink. Unauthorized selling of
9 alcoholic drinks is any of the following acts:

13 (17) Selling of alcoholic drinks on Christmas Eve and New Year’s Eve, starting
14 from 0001 hours to 2400 hours, for each particular date, except where the holder of

1 a restaurant license is permitted to sell alcoholic drinks to a person who has
2 displayed a valid identification card and is a seated diner of a restaurant ordering
3 alcoholic drinks as part of a meal. The selling of which is permitted from 1300
4 hours to 2100 hours on Christmas Eve and 1300 hours to 2400 hours on New
5 Year's Eve."

6 Section 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor
7 or upon its becoming law without such approval.


