A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Title 7 of the Kosrae State Code, by amending Section 7.1208 thereof, to clarify the prescribed rates to be used for compensating Board Directors of the Kosrae Utility Authority; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act isto amend Section 7.1208 of Title 7 of
2 the Kosrae State Code to clarify the compensating rate that should be applied to KUA
3 Board of Directors, a governing agency, to be consistent with Section 7.113 of the Kosrae
4 State Code.

5 Section 2. Amendment. Section 7.1208 of Title 7 of the Kosrase State Code is
6 hereby amended to read as follows:

7 “Section 7.1208. Organization of the Board; quorum; compensation and expenses.
8 Pursuant to its bylaws, the Board organizes by electing one of its members as Chairman
9 and another as Vice-Chariman. The Board also designates from among its members a
10 Secretary to keep the minutes and records of the Board. Any three members fo the Board
11 constitute a quorum, and a concurrence of three members is necessary for any official
12 action taken by the Board. No vacancy in the membership of the Board impairs the right
13 of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all of the duties of the Board. Directors
14 ~~are~~ shall be compensated at ~~established~~ the rates prescribed under Section 7.113 of the
15 Kosrae State Code, when actually attending meetings of the Board, except the Director of
16 the Department of Transportation and Infrastructre who does not receive additional

1 compensation. All Directors receive travel expenses and per diem at Kosrae State
2 Government rates when these amounts would be payable to Kosrae State Government
3 employees in the same circumstances.”

4 Section 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor
5 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
