A RESOLUTION

Amending Rule 4.8 of the Kosrae State Legislature's Rules of Procedure to modify the requirements for Committee reports.

WHEREAS, with the current provisions of Rule 4.8 of the Kosrae State Legislature's, oral reports are permissible based on the circumstances of each measure as well as condolence, recognition and appreciation resolutions; and

WHEREAS, Rule 4.8 of the Kosrae State Legislature currently states,
Rule 4.8. Committee Report of Measures. Following its treatment of a measure a
committee submits a written or an oral report of its findings and recommendations to the
Legislature. Based on the nature of a measure, the Legislature by majority vote shall
decide whether or not it is necessary to reduce an oral report in writing. Before acting on
the measure the Legislature acts on the report. A position of dissent may be taken, or a
minority report made, by a committee member

A report shall be considered adopted by a committee when a majority of the members of the committee have signed the report concurring therein. Signing a report "with reservation" is counted as a concurring therein. A member not concurring with the report of the majority may so indicate by signing the report "I do not concur" or by submitting a separate minority report. A majority report may be submitted during discussion of the motion to adopt a committee report on the same bill, resolution or other matter. The majority report as submitted becomes part of the discussion and therefore

WHEREAS, Rule 4.8 of the Kosrae State Legislature's Rules of Procedure is
