A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$14,909,292 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$6,439,886 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,270,566 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$33,128 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

Section 1. <u>Appropriations</u>. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$9,251,151 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$3,455,574, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund; and the sum of \$1,192,571 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United States Grant Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

Section 2. <u>Apportionment</u>. <u>Operation of the Executive</u>. The sums appropriated by Section 1 of this act are apportioned as follows:
