A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Title 19 of the Kosrae State Code by amending Section 19.816, to allow applicable and respective municipal governments to be involved in the enforcement of laws governing identified state protected area system, and to further allow for municipal government share in fees and fines collected; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to amend Title 19 of the Kosrae State Code by amending Section 19.816, to allow applicable and respective municipal governments to be involved in the enforcement of laws governing identified state protected area system, and to further allow for municipal government share in fees and fines collected; and for other purposes.

Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. Title 19, Chapter 8, Section 19.816 of the Kosrae State Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 19.816. Enforcement.

1) If the Administrator or an authorized personnel determines that any person has violated or is violating this Chapter, any regulation adopted pursuant to this Chapter, or any permit or authorization issued pursuant to this Chapter, the Administrator shall serve written notice by certified mail or personal service upon the alleged violator or violators specifying the alleged violation. The notice may include:
