Sigrah was the youngest sibling among four (4) brothers and six (6) sisters of Joseph Skilling and Ruth Joseph Skilling; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the late Nipastu Carrie H. Sigrah was married to the late Pastu Hanson Kun 6 Sigrah, who was a devoted husband and dedicated father, who had served the Kosrae State 7 Government as an Educator and Administrator (Chief of Curriculum and Instructions) under the 8 Department of Education for a great number of years; and 9 WHEREAS, the late Nipastu Carrie H. Sigrah, who had graduated with a Bachelors of 10 Arts degree from the United States International University (USIU) in San Diego, California, had also later dedicated much of her time serving the Kosrae State Government for a total of thirty-11 nine (39) years as a Classroom Teacher for the Kosrae High School, which she began her 12 13 teaching career in September of 1976 until her resignation (due to health-related reasons) in 14 January of 2015; and 15 WHEREAS, the late Nipastu Carrie H. Sigrah, during her teaching career, was also 16 known to be among the few teachers at the time to fulfill both BASIC and ADVANCED

requirements of the FSM Teacher Certification Policy, which was a strict requirement imposed 1 2 on all teachers; and 3 WHEREAS, the late Nipastu Carrie H. Sigrah, aside from her professional work career, 4 was also well-regarded by her family and the community as a passionate musician and song 5 composer; She was also well-respected by her community for her strong Christian faith, having 6 received the distinct title of "Nipastu" following her late husband's ordination as Pastor for the 7 Tafunsak Congregational Church; and 8 WHEREAS, the late Nipastu Carrie H. Sigrah is survived by her sons Kun "Meivo" 9 Sigrah [married to formerly Julie Midley Shrew], Joseph "Hammer" Sigrah [married to formerly 10 Sepe Minoru Charley], Hanson "Junior" Sigrah [married to formerly Panne Harry Seymour] 11 daughter RuthJoan P.
