Your Standing Committee on Environment, Transportation, Communication, and Infrastructure (ETC&I) reports on L.R. 13-31 entitled:

“Consenting and confirming the nomination for Mr. Mallun A. Talley to serve as a Board of Director for the Kosrae Island Resource Management Authority (KIRMA).”

COMMITTEE ACTIONS:

Your committee met in an Executive meeting on Wednesday, March 29, 2023 around 10:00 am to deliberate on this nomination.

During the meeting, the committee assigned the Acting Chairperson to meet up with KIRMA Director and nominee to inquire their opinion: whether they agree or not to the appointment made by the Governor.

Your committee met again in an Executive meeting on Tuesday, April 4, 2023 around 10:50 am and continued their discussions based on inquiries regarding Chairperson’s visit to KIRMA Director and nominee, Mr. Mallun A. Talley.

COMMITTEE FINDINGS:

The intent of the subject resolution is clearly stated in its title.

As assigned by the committee, the Acting Chairperson met up with KIRMA Director and the nominee, who were both aware of the appointment made by the Governor. According to the Acting Chairperson’s report to the committee, the KIRMA Director agreed to the appointment and expressed his willing to work with the nominee. Similar to the nominee, he was aware of the nomination and also expressed his interest to serve as a Board Member for the KIRMA Board of Directors.


During the committee’s following meeting, the committee with less discussion, agreed to move forward on the resolution by reporting out.




