7 later on as a Legislative Secretary II in 1997; the same year, recruited as the Chief
8 Legislative Secretary from 1997 to 2000; and eventually becoming the Speaker's
9 Secretary starting in 2018 until the PRESENT, all of which she has successfully served a
10 total of eleven (11) legislative political terms, from 3rd State Legislature to the 13th State
11 Legislature; and

12 **WHEREAS**, during her tenure as a Page Clerk, Chief Page Clerk, Legislative
13 Secretary II, Chief Legislative Secretary, and the Speaker's Secretary, Mrs. Mike is
14 directly responsible to the Speaker of the Legislature and the Chief Clerk. Her primary
15 duties and responsibilities include performing tasks for the Committee of the Whole
16 when the Legislature is in session or hearings; maintaining files and other documentary
17 materials for easy access; responsible for maintaining a clean and orderly committee

2 resolutions; responsible for the Legislative Secretaries' non-committee service to the
3 members of the Legislature, visiting officials, and dignitaries; responsible for overseeing
4 the work of the Legislative Secretaries; understanding the basic procedural rules of the
5 Legislature; preparing documents at the discretion of the Chief Clerk for the Legislature's
6 sessions or public hearings; copying and properly putting in order documents that
7 accurately follow the agenda for meetings; staffing Senators on non-committee matters;
8 assisting the compilation of the journals by reviewing the journal, transcription, and
9 proofreading.; and performing other duties assigned by the Presiding Officers of the
10 Legislature and the Chief Clerk; and

11 **WHEREAS**, throughout the years working for the State Legislature, Mrs. Mike
12 has forged a great working relationship with her fellow colleagues, as well as past and
13 present members of the Kosrae State Legislature. She is famously known by her
14 colleagues and employers to be openly-friendly, courteous, enthusiastic, passionate, and
15 trustworthy, among others; and

16 **WHEREAS**, it is with these fostered skills, knowledge, and experience that
17 inspire her younger peers to strive harder. It is indeed with these professional and


1 service and dedication to the people and State Government of Kosrae, most particularly
