A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the Kosrae State Code by amending Section 12.101 under Chapter 1 of Part 1 of Title 12 of the Kosrae State Code; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to amend the Kosrae State Code by
2 amending Section 12.101 under Chapter 1 of Part 1 of Title 12 of the Kosrae State Code to
3 permit during a school year for reduction of hours of classroom instruction that apply to
4 respectively first and second graders, third graders and fourth through to twelfth graders
5 during any time a State of Emergency is in force during a school year; and for other
6 purposes.

7 Section 2. Amendment. Title 12, Part 1, Chapter 1, Section 12.101 of the Kosrae
8 State Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 “Section 12.101. School Year. The school year for all schools consists of no fewer
10 than six hundred fifty hours of classroom instruction for first and second graders, and no
11 fewer than eight hundred hours of classroom instruction for third graders and no fewer
12 than nine hundred hours of classroom instruction for fourth through to twelfth graders .

13 Provided that in circumstances where a State of Emergency is in force during a school
14 year or any part thereof the hours of classroom instruction specified respectively for first
15 and second graders, third graders and fourth through to twelfth graders may be reduced in
16 any way as the Director of the Department of Education shall see fit. The Director of the

1 Department of Education establishes beginning and ending dates of the school year to suit
2 Government school needs and customs?"

3 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act takes effect upon the approval of the Governor
4 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
